There are many kinds of social workers that include child, family and school; healthcare; mental health/clinical; substance abuse; developmental disabilities; employment/occupational; justice/corrections; aging; child welfare; and public welfare. ### SALARY

The median annual earnings of social workers with a bachelor's degree in May 2012 were \$38,100. Overall, employment of social workers is projected to grow 19 percent from 2012 - 2022, faster than the average for all occupations (U.S. Department of Labor).
