JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR 4-YEAR GRADUATES

Many college students share the view that sociology offers few practical employment options. We often hear “What does one do with a degree in sociology?” The truth is that sociology majors are well-prepared for the work force as well as graduate training in a multitude of areas. Those trained in sociology are equipped to wear many hats. Sociology majors have a background in social and cultural knowledge which allows them to meet the needs of a complex global environment. Sociology instills the ability to understand complex situations and solve problems in an ever-changing world. Those with a bachelor’s in Sociology find employment in many areas which include, but are not limited to: administration, advertising, banking, business, counseling, community organizing, health services, journalism, marketing, and market research, sales, education, consulting, criminal justice, social services, and social research.

SALARY

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics in May 2010, the median annual wage of sociologists was \$72,360. Typically students entering the job markets with a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology can expect to earn about \$35,000 annually. A Master of Arts or Doctorate can raise the estimated salary by \$43,731 a year, or higher.
