PROGRAM INFORMATION

Are you a risk-taker? Want to be a creative problem solver? Would you like to organize and manage new ideas? If so, consider the Entrepreneurship Technical Major.

The Entrepreneurship Technical Major has been developed for those students who desire to own their own, or work within the small business environment. Our E-Ship program has been structured to include coursework that will develop the student's foundational business knowledge so that they can successfully compete in the small business environment. The program also concentrates on the core business functions by way of small business examples, applications and opportunities. Once the student has completed the E-Ship core course work, they will then as a final requirement, create their own all important business plan (and defend this plan) in the program capstone course.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

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SALARY

As a small business operation, salaries can vary greatly depending on many factors including: experience, industry, location, competition, start-up versus established business, and more.

TECH PREP SCHOLARSHIP

Owens Community College offers Tech Prep scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have participated in a Tech Prep career pathway within the Greater Northwest Ohio Tech Prep Consortium. The maximum award is \$2,000 total (\$1,000 per year) or \$500 per semester for four semesters to cover tuition, fees, and an allotment for books **that are not covered** by other financial aid, such as Federal Pell Grant, as long as the student maintains eligibility. This scholarship does not pay for supplies, lab fees, course fees, and other institutional fees. Students must earn a 2.5 on a 4.0 GPA scale by the end of the 7th semester of high school. They must enroll at Owens, full time, for the fall semester immediately following high school graduation, and declare an associate degree program related to the chosen high school Tech Prep pathway.
