Note: The American Culinary Federation Education Foundation accredits Owens Baking and Pastry Certificate. Graduates of the certificate are exempt from testing but must have completed one-year of employment to earn Certified Pastry Culinarian credential.

* AY 2019 on-time completion is defined as those graduating within 150% of program length. Normal time for an associate's degree is 2-years; therefore, on-time completion is within 3-years of program entry. Normal time for a one-year certificate is one-year; therefore, on-time completion is within 1.5 years of program entry.
