Highlights

Overall College Totals

- Overall headcount enrollment declined -7.2% between Fall 2016 and 2017; It declined -6.5% on the Toledo-area campus and -11.8% on the Findlay-area campus
- The number of International students has been declining over the past four years, from 171 in 2014 to 84 in 2016 and 62 in 2017, representing a -26.2% drop in the last year alone
- The total number of Veteran students jumped 65.0% from 377 in 2016 to 622 in 2017. This increase reflects an expansion to the veteran definition which took place between Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 and was adopted in response to a change in state reporting. The definition now includes more self-reported information gathered from interest codes in Banner that are populated from web and paper applications to the college.

Totals Excluding Non-Matriculating and High School Students*

- Overall headcount enrollment excluding High School and Non-Matriculating students declined -10.8%, including -10.0% on the Toledo-area campus and -15.2% on the Findlay-area campus
- 62.9% of the student body (excluding Non-Matriculating and High School students) is attending part-time, with 15.5% taking 0-5.xx credit hours and 47.4% taking between 6-11.xx credit hours. The percentage of part-time students has risen from 57.9% in 2013.
- 58% of the student body (excluding Non-Matriculating and High School students) is female: 57.3% on the Toledo-area campus and 62.5% on the Findlay-area campus
- Excluding Non-Matriculating and High School students, 53.1% of the student body is from Lucas County, 17.6% from Wood, 8.5% from Hancock, and less than 3% from all others
