Policy. A student may audit a course according to the guidelines established by the office of the provost. To audit means to enroll for a reason other than to receive a course grade and credit. Guidelines for auditing courses are in the on-line college catalog on the Owens community college web site.

~~(O) Purpose. To audit means to enroll for a course for some reason other than to receive a course grade and credit.~~

~~(P) Guidelines:~~

- ~~(1) Audit status must be indicated on the registration form and filed in the record's office at the time of registration.~~
- ~~(2) An audit must be declared by the first week of class.~~
- ~~(3) Auditing a course does not create a waiver for any fee assessed.~~
- ~~(4) An audited course will be noted as "AU" on a student's transcript.~~
