## Dental Assistant Radiographer

4715-12-03 Certificate Renewal

Dental Assistants must complete at least two hours of continuing education in radiation technology from a board-approved biennial or permanent sponsor during the two-year period immediately preceding renewal, and shall be renewed in accordance with the standard renewal procedure of sections 4745.01 to 4745.03 of the Revised Code. The failure of a certificate holder to renew his registration in accordance with this rule shall result in an automatic suspension of his certificate to practice as a dental assistant radiographer.

## Local Anesthesia for Dental Hygienists

Proper anesthesia knowledge, skills and techniques are critical to today's dental hygienists. This state-approved course combines online study and hands-on clinical at Owens' dental hygiene lab to help you build those skills. The course prepares you to take the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners (NERB) local anesthesia exam, which is required for dental hygienists to become licensed in Ohio. This course has been approved by the Ohio State Dental Board and follows the guidelines in the Revised Code 4715.231 and the Ohio Administrative Code 4715-9-01(D). 12 hours of online course work must be completed prior to the first class.

## Nitrous Oxide Administration Course

This course meets the new regulations for administration of Nitrous Oxide for the Dental Hygienist in accordance with rule 4715-9-01.2 in the Ohio Administrative Code. The course is the equivalent of a six hour course which includes a 2 hour online didactic course plus another 2 hours of didactic instruction (4 hour didactic total) and two hours of clinical experience. Successful completion of a written examination and a clinical competency are required to receive a 6 CEU certificate for the course.

## Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office

This course helps dental hygienists to recognize the symptoms, first aid treatment and possible outcomes for patients who exhibit a variety of emergencies in the dental office, including cardiovascular disease, insulin reactions and epileptic seizures. This course has been approved by the Ohio State Dental Board and follows the guidelines in the Revised Code 4715.231 and the Ohio Administrative Code 4715-9-01(D).
